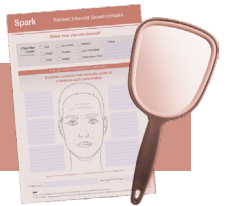


**T**ilt

Be sure to assess for symmetry  
Remember to consider **concavities, convexities, and contours**  
that affect the interplay of facial light and shadows



A mirror and the patient's Patient Interest  
Questionnaire can be helpful tools



### Put **ART** into action in your office

#### The **ART** of Consultation

##### **Ask**

Ask open-ended questions to initiate a global assessment

##### **Review**

Review your assessment with the patient and talk about treatment outcomes

##### **Treat**

Treat according to agreed-upon priorities and build satisfaction

#### The **ART** of Assessment®

##### **Animate**

Ask the patient to make facial expressions

##### **Rotate**

Look at the patient from side and oblique views

##### **Tilt**

Have the patient look up and down
