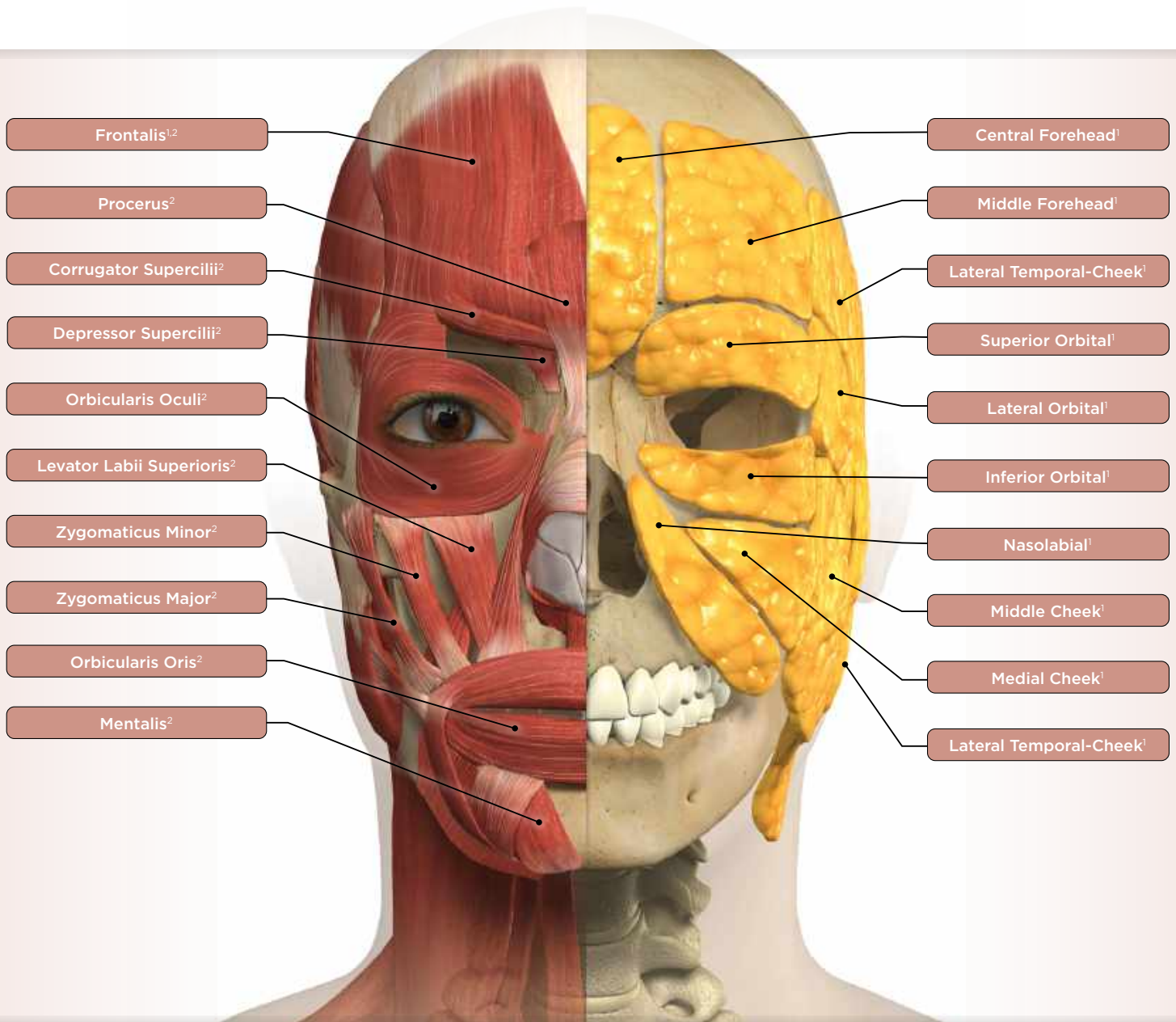


Consider facial anatomy during patient consultations

During assessment, it is important to discuss facial anatomy with patients in determining the best treatment approach

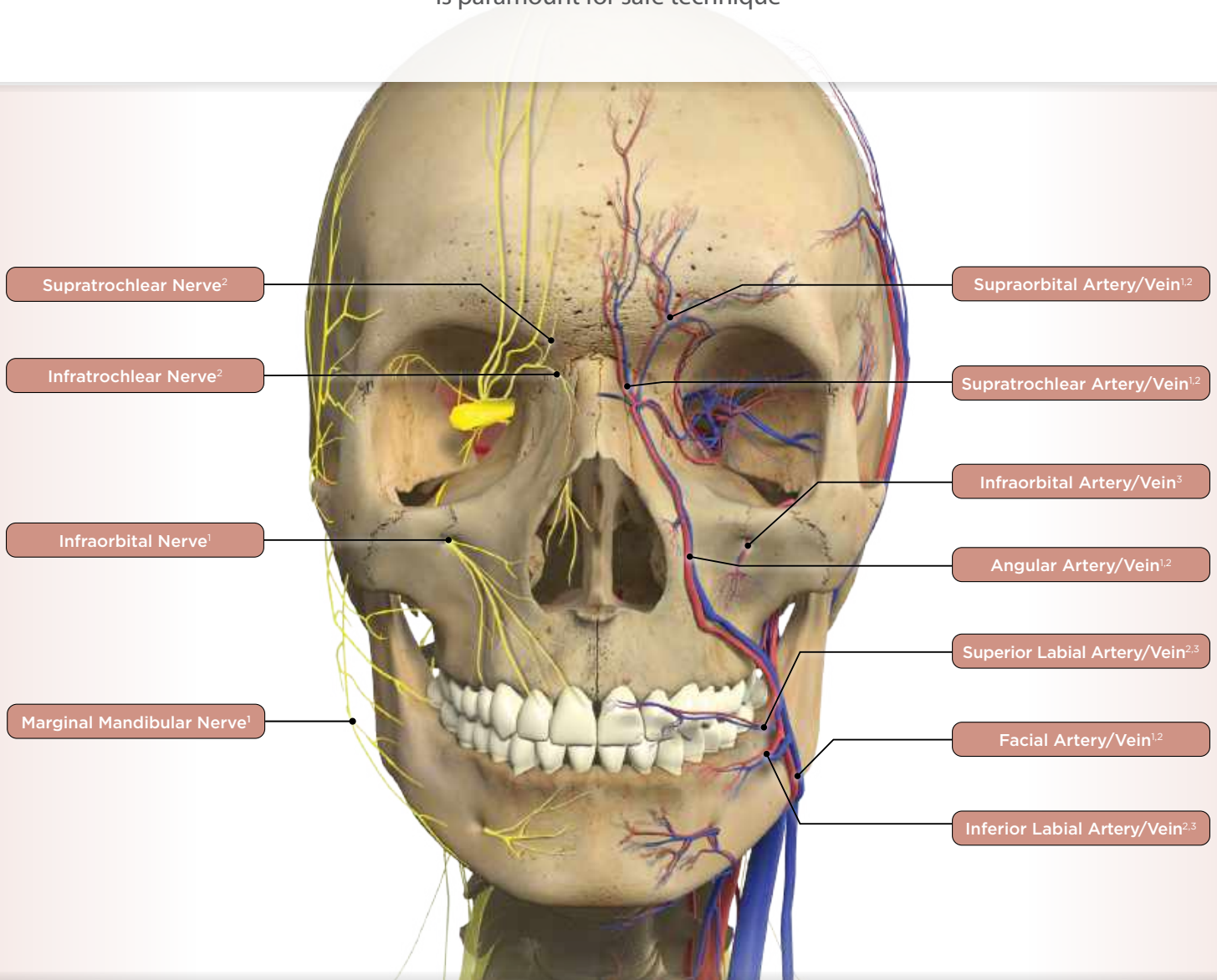


Reviewing the functional relationships of key anatomy with the patient can help you confidently identify and recommend areas for treatment
